

First Presbyterian Church Memorial Scholarship Repeat Applicants

Amount of scholarship: Up to \$1000 for books, tuition, and fees. The amount of the award will not exceed the cost of these items for one year.

Purpose: To assist financially in the education or training of First Presbyterian members in order that they may pursue post-high-school education including undergraduate or graduate work, vocational or technical training, or any specialized training to upgrade skills to meet certification requirements, to qualify for higher-level employment, or to retrain for a new career.

Eligibility: Scholarship recipients must be members of First Presbyterian Church and admitted to an accredited college or training program to meet the training needs of the student. The scholarship is awarded on an annual basis. An individual may reapply annually until his or her education program is completed.

Basis of selection:

Character – The recipient's character should be such that he or she will be a credit to the church and the community. The recipient should reflect a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

Ambition – A personal desire to continue his or her education and a demonstrated willingness to work diligently toward that goal.

Ability – High achievement in high school and college classes, good college entrance test scores (ACT, SAT, etc., when applicable), performance in work and/or volunteer activities that indicate the ability to succeed in the proposed program.

Need – Evidence of a legitimate financial need in order to complete the program. Equal consideration will be given to non-traditional students.

Application and Selection Process:

The applicant must submit a completed application form to the Chair of the Higher Education Committee by **April 1**. Recipients will be selected by the Committee and notified of the Committee's decision by May 1. Funds will be given to the institution the recipient plans to attend upon presentation of proof of acceptance by that institution.
