

Salt and Light / Hutton Memorial Scholarship

Amount of Scholarship: Up to \$1,000 to be used for books, tuition, and fees. The amount of the award will not exceed the cost of these items for one year. The quantity of scholarships and the dollar amount of each scholarship awarded annually will be determined by the scholarship committee.

Purpose: To assist financially in the education or training of First Presbyterian Church and Wichita Redeemer Congregational Church members in order that they may pursue post high school education including graduate or undergraduate work, vocational or technical training, or any specialized training to upgrade skills to meet certification requirements, to qualify for higher level employment, or to retrain for a new career.

Eligibility: Scholarship recipients must be participants in the life of First Presbyterian Church or Wichita Redeemer Congregational Church and admitted to an accredited college or training program that will meet the goals of the student. The scholarship is awarded on an annual basis. An individual may reapply for the grant annually until his or her educational program is completed.

Basis of Selection:

Character—The recipient's character should be such that he or she will be a credit to the church and community. The recipient should reflect a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

Ambition—A personal desire to continue his or her education and a demonstrated willingness to work diligently toward that goal.

Ability—High achievement in high school and college classes, good college entrance test scores (ACT, SAT, etc., when applicable), performance in work or volunteer activities that would indicate the ability to succeed in the proposed program.

Need—Evidence of a legitimate financial need to complete the planned program. Equal consideration will be given to non-traditional students.
